## Pool Rules

**The Fence and Gate Surrounding the Pool are for Resident Protection.**  
**The Gate is to Remain Locked and Rules Must Be Followed at All Times.**

**Hours: 6:00 AM to 9:00 PM**

**Adult members have the responsibility to enforce rules to ensure the safety of all patrons.**

1. The pool area is for homeowners and their guests only. All guests must be accompanied by an adult homeowner member, and members are legally responsible for damages caused by family or guests. Children age 14 and under must be accompanied by an adult age 18 or older who is a Homeowners Association member or an appointed guardian.
2. Proper swimwear is required; no cut-offs allowed in the pool. Swim diapers are required for children under age three and those who are not toilet trained.
3. No diving from the side of the pool, running in the pool area, or excessive "horsesplay". Conduct deemed to be dangerous, unreasonable, offensive, or abusive, and extreme noise levels of any kind, should be reported to Westwood Property Management at 615-794-1411. The Association is authorized to send notification to the Owner, so an address of the offender will need to be provided.
4. No bicycles, rollerblades, skateboards, scooters, or motorized cycles of any kind are allowed in the pool area.
5. No pets or animals are allowed inside or tied outside of fence.
6. No glass containers allowed.
7. No smoking, alcoholic beverages, firearms or drugs allowed.
8. Please dispose of trash or waste properly; food shall be consumed in areas at least 10 feet away from the pool.
9. Floatation devices are limited to 2-person carrier size. No rafts, chairs, boats or devices larger than 2 feet by 3 feet are allowed.
10. Any damage or cost incurred by the Association due to damages or negligence will be billed to the homeowner. Any individual(s) committing acts of vandalism to the pool or adjacent areas will lose all pool privileges, to be determined by the Association Board, and be held responsible for cleaning and/or repair.
