

**SPENCER HALL POOL RULES  
SUMMER 2023**

**By using the pool you agree to the following Spencer Hall Pool rules and timeframes:**

8 AM to 9 AM	<b>ADULT SWIM ONLY</b>
8 AM to 10 PM	EVERYBODY HOURS
9 PM to 10 PM	NOISE REDUCTION HOUR

Please note the pool is C LOSED at 10PM. **Your fob will not work after 10:15PM**

1. ALL persons using the pool must use common sense and common courtesy.
2. All persons using the pool do so at their OWN RISK ~ There is NO lifeguard on duty.
3. Please shower before entering the pool if excessively sweaty, dirty, or if you have excessive suntan lotion on your body. Excess suntan lotion contributes to pool murkiness.
4. Accidents must be reported immediately to the Management Company ~ Call 255-8531.
5. The Pool Committee and the Spencer Hall Homeowners Association reserve the right to suspend residents' pool privileges when pool rules are broken or if persons are engaged in other disruptive behaviors.
6. Children ages 14 and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Children ages 15-17 can be at the pool without direct parent supervision with up to 2 guests, but are still the responsibility of their parents. Residents 18 years or older are permitted up to 4 guests. All guests must be accompanied by a resident, and residents are legally responsible for the actions of their guests. Homeowners are legally responsible for their tenant's use of the pool.
7. Running, horseplay, and excessive splashing are not permitted.
8. NO skateboards or roller blades are allowed in the pool area.
9. NO pets are allowed in the pool area.
10. We strive for a family friendly environment: This means NO cursing, NO excessive public display of affection (PDA), NO public intoxication, and modest swimwear is required.
11. Children that are not potty trained must use rubber pants or a designated swim diaper. Potty accidents will result in the pool being closed down and cause a loss of swim time for other residents.
12. NO glass containers of any kind are permitted in the pool area. Residents found with glass bottles will lose pool privileges. Any resident found to have broken glass in the pool area will be assessed the full costs of having the pool drained, cleaned, re-filled, and re-inspected. These costs are substantial.
13. All residents and guests are responsible for their trash and must dispose of it. Please clean up after yourself and/or your group, and keep the pool area litter free.
14. Any damages occurring in the pool complex will be assessed to the responsible homeowner. Violators should be reported to the Management Company. Please Call 615-255-8531 to report pool vandalism or damages.
15. Please notify the pool committee of any planned private parties. Private parties are limited to 10 people and do not exclude residents from using the pool.
16. There will be a \$25.00 charge for replacement key fobs for the pool gate.
